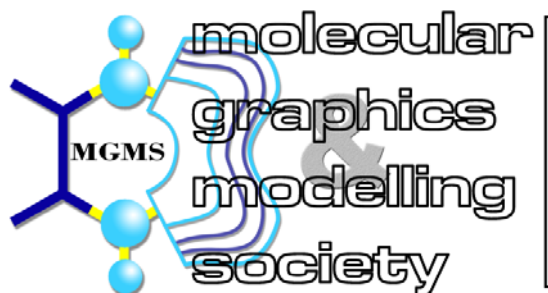


MGMS Lecture Tour 2011
